Through the Historic Preservation Grants Program, NSDAR provides financial support for local community projects which exemplify the Society's historic preservation mission.

AWARDS

There are three awards given by the committee:

- **Historic Preservation Medal:** recognizes and honors an individual who has done extraordinary historical preservation over a long period of time.
- **Historic Preservation Recognition Award:** recognizes and honors an individual or group that has done recent remarkable volunteer work at the community level.
- **Historic Preservation Project Contest:** provides a path to recognize worthy chapter and state projects at the state, division, and national levels.
