The purpose of the Chapter Achievement Award is to measure the health of your chapter. By utilizing the information found on the Committee portion of our national website and the form for recording your accomplishments, you will be able to measure your chapter's progress toward achieving the goals you set for yourselves. Log into the Members site, then click on "Committees" near the top of the page. Select Chapter Achievement Awards under **Administrative**Committees.

Each year's accomplishments are measured from January 1 through December 31. Watch for our 2021 CMR to be posted soon, and go ahead and get started as soon as you can. You can save your input, then re-open later for additions or editing. Now is the time to check out the 2021 Planning Guide and the 2021 Checklist, both posted for you on this website. Work with your committees to plan the goals you wish to achieve this year, and the activities in which your chapter will want to participate to reach these goals. Donations can be planned and made throughout the year. It is better to submit donations to National by the first week in December to allow time for processing. However, <u>some</u> donations can be made as late as Dec. 24. You should find the "What's New" information, found on the right side of the Chapter Achievement Awards page, very helpful. Remember, the Levels your chapter can earn are: Level 1 (400+ points,) Level 2 (300+ points,) and Level 3 (200+ points.)

The 2021 Checklist will also help you with planning for your chapter. An important deadline is that the <u>National dues for</u> your chapter must be postmarked no later than <u>December 1, 2021 to receive credit</u>. The Chapter Achievement form is a part of the Chapter Master Report and must be completed on-line through e-membership access. <u>The deadline for submission is January 31, 2022</u>. <u>Paper copies will not be accepted</u>.

There are no changes in criteria or points to be earned on the CAA this year from 2020. The verbiage on Section 9 is different, but only for purposes of clarification. Please Remember To Submit Your Section 8 Donations
PROPERLY FOR THEM TO COUNT. This year the top five scoring chapters in the state will again receive a certificate of recognition at Continental Congress. These chapters will also receive a badge to be posted on their websites.
