Summary of Recommendations from the KSDAR Executive Committee Presented to the State Board of Management on 10 September 2020

Recommendation 1. That the decision to establish and appoint members to the Kansas Scholarship Special Committee be ratified.

Explanation: This special committee's purpose is to propose a course of action for the KSDAR Special Scholarships including the Genevieve Pendleton Memorial Endowment Scholarship, Elizabeth M. Kessler Scholarship, Gladys E. Routh Memorial Scholarship, and Kansas DAR Scholarship. The authority can be found in KSDAR Bylaws, Article VII, Duties of Officers, Section 2, State Regent; and Article XI Committees, Section 10, Other Committees. Members of the committee and additional information will be provided in the September issue of the CyberSunflower.

Recommendation 2. That the decision to establish and appoint members to the Kansas 125th Anniversary Special Committee be ratified.

Explanation: This special committee's purpose is to facilitate statewide plans to observe and commemorate the 125th anniversary of the Kansas Society Daughters of the American Revolution. The authority can be found in KSDAR Bylaws, Article VII, Duties of Officers, Section 2, State Regent; and Article XI Committees, Section 10, Other Committees. Members of the committee and additional information will be provided in the September issue of the CyberSunflower.

Recommendation 3. That the proposed 2020 and 2021 budgets be adopted.

Explanation: Per Article XI, Committees, Section 5. Finance Committee, the budget for the year shall be presented at the Board of Management meeting preceding State Conference. In the absence of meeting in person, the budgets for both 2020 and 2021 have been presented for consideration.

Recommendation 4. That the 2021 KSDAR Scholarship be funded at \$1,500 and the 2021 KSDAR Good Citizen Scholarship be funded at \$750 per student for a total of \$1,500, each to be paid from the Designated Fund.

Explanation: Amounts as recommended by the Finance Committee, and as noted in Special Scholarship Section, numbers 4 and 5. Changes to the DAR Good Citizens scholarship at the National level now allow for each state to recognize one male and one female award recipient.
