

2021 Amendments to the Bylaws of the Kansas Society of the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution

All numbered amendments below would be covered under the motion (if adopted by delegates) allowing the Bylaws Committee to correct article and section designations, punctuation, and cross-references and to make such other technical and conforming changes as may be necessary to reflect the intent of the Society in connection with the Kansas DAR Bylaws. (RONR pg. 567, 57:19). Other amendments are automatic.

These are inserted in our current bylaws (draft) in green font.

AMENDMENT #19: Amend Kansas Society of the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution Bylaws by striking out “State” from “Kansas State Society” in the following areas:

RATIONALE: Bylaws cannot be in conflict with the official name of organization. The official name of KSDAR does not contain the word “State”

Amendment #20: Amend ARTICLE IX, State Board of Management, Section 3. Meetings. by striking out “the” before “September” in second sentence.

ARTICLE IX, State Board of Management, Section 3. Meetings. Regular meetings of the State Board of Management shall be held at the call of the State Regent, at least twice a year. One meeting shall be held in the September preceding the Annual District Meetings and the second meeting shall immediately precede the State Conference. Except in cases of emergency, at least thirty days' notice of the time and location of the meetings shall be given.	Amend ARTICLE IX, State Board of Management, Section 3. Meetings. by striking out “the” before “September” in second sentence.	ARTICLE IX, State Board of Management, Section 3. Meetings. Regular meetings of the State Board of Management shall be held at the call of the State Regent, at least twice a year. Except in cases of emergency, at least thirty days' notice of the time and location of the meetings shall be given.

Rationale: The word “the” should not precede “September”

Amendment #21: Amend ARTICLE XI, Committees, Section 14. Transfer of Records and Property. by striking out “ship” and inserting “position”

Amend ARTICLE XI, Committees, Section 14. Transfer of Records and Property. by striking out “ship” and inserting “position”	ARTICLE XI, Committees, Section 14. Transfer of Records and Property. At the completion of her term, each State Committee Chair shall deliver to the State Regent or, if so instructed, to the newly appointed State Chair of her committee, a written procedure of the requirements of her chair position, a list of the KSDAR property in her custody, and all records and property of the Kansas Society, and she shall obtain a receipt for these items.

RATIONALE: Corrects flow of sentence after a previous change to this section (“chair ship” is awkward).

Amendment #22: Amend ARTICLE XII, Districts, Section 3. Meetings. (b) by striking out “the” before “September” in first sentence.

RATIONALE: The word “the” should not precede “September”

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AMENDMENT #23: Amend ARTICLE XIII, Chapters, Section 8. Chapter Registrar by striking out “11” and inserting “10”

The Chapter Registrar shall report to the Organizing Secretary General, in writing, all changes in membership, marriages, divorces, deaths, resignations, transfers, and changes of address as they occur (Bylaws of the National Society, ARTICLE XIII, Section 11).	Amend ARTICLE XIII, Chapters, Section 8. by striking out “11” and inserting “10”	ARTICLE XIII, Chapters, Section 8. Chapter Registrar. The Chapter Registrar shall report to the Organizing Secretary General, in writing, all changes in membership, marriages, divorces, deaths, resignations, transfers, and changes of address as they occur (Bylaws of the National Society, ARTICLE XIII, Section 10).

RATIONALE: This amendment corrects an incorrect section of the NSDAR Bylaws that was referenced.

AMENDMENT #24: Amend Standing Rule Number 10 by striking out Madonna of the Trail Fund and the Marker Preservation Fund and inserting **Historic Markers Fund** and striking out “original funds” and inserting “fund” in last sentence.

Standing Rule Number 10. The money from the Madonna of the Trail Fund and the Marker Preservation Fund shall be put in short term Certificates of Deposits at the best rate available for a short term in an FDIC-insured bank or saving institution, with interest to be deposited back to the original funds.	Amend Standing Rule Number 10 by striking out Madonna of the Trail Fund and the Marker Preservation Fund and inserting Historic Markers Fund and striking out “original funds” and inserting “fund” in last sentence.	Stand Rule Number 10. The money from the Historic Markers Fund shall be put in short term Certificates of Deposits at the best rate available for a short term in an FDIC-insured bank or saving institution, with interest to be deposited back to the fund.

RATIONALE: The Madonna of the Trail Fund and the Marker Preservation Fund were combined into one fund called the Historic Markers Fund. Since those funds are now the Historic Markers Fund, “original funds” should be changed to “fund”

Amend ARTICLE II title by inserting “s” at the end of the title “Object”

RATIONALE: KSDAR Bylaws may not conflict with NSDAR Bylaws.

Amend ARTICLE XIII, Chapters, Section 7. Chapter Treasurer. (a) by striking out \$40.00 and inserting \$42.00

(a) Each year the Chapter Treasurer shall remit to the Office of the Organizing Secretary General the annual national dues of \$40.00 per chapter member, payable to the Treasurer General NSDAR, showing a Federal Postal Service, or other carrier, cancellation date no later than December 1.	Amend ARTICLE XIII, Chapters, Section 7. Chapter Treasurer. (a) by striking out \$40.00 and inserting \$42.00	ARTICLE XIII, Chapters, Section 7. Chapter Treasurer. (a) Each year the Chapter Treasurer shall remit to the Office of the Organizing Secretary General the annual national dues of \$42.00 per chapter member, payable to the Treasurer General NSDAR, showing a Federal Postal Service, or other carrier, cancellation date no later than December 1.

RATIONALE: KSDAR Bylaws may not conflict with NSDAR Bylaws.
