The Passport contains 15 activities to show your Service

for Veterans commitment. Most of these activities are already ones you have been doing every year. So this will be a Super Easy challenge, but one that will be very impactful!

Participation begins Oct. 1, 2021 and continues through Apr. 1, 2022. Each activity completed must be stamped by either your <u>Chapter Service for Veterans</u> <u>Chair</u> or your <u>Chapter Regent</u> when completed.

There will be a drawing for a Chapter Prize and an Individual Prize at Spring Conference. Passports considered for prizes <u>must be sent to the KSDAR Service</u> <u>for Veterans Chair no later than Apr. 15, 2022</u>. The Chapter with the most members completing at least 10 activities will receive the Chapter Award (percentage based on membership). A minimum of 5 activities is required for an Individual prize drawing.

If you were not able to pick up a Passport at Registration, Chapter Regents will also be emailed the Printable version for their members. There is also a printable version available here; just print and quarter-fold to make your passport!
